

Bethany Logo Doodle Challenge Doodles Away

You've heard of a Google Doodle? These are the creative alterations that Google does to its trademark symbol. They can represent holidays, famous people or events, and other themes that match the current atmosphere or day. Here is the Google Trademark:



This is the logo at the head of their search pages. Periodically they will alter this logo, and the end result is called a Google Doodle. Below are examples of doodles.

Notice: The Google trademark is incorporated into each design.



Doodles also include explanations of the doodle. Such as this one:
Today's Doodle pays homage to Sitara Devi, the legendary Kathak dancer who was described as Nritya Samragini ("Empress of Dance") for her vibrant energy, effortless footwork, and unparalleled ability to bring a story to life.

Her performances on and off the silver screen revived popular interest in the classical dance of Kathak. Showcases at international venues such as the Royal Albert Hall, London and Carnegie Hall, New York brought the dance form a global audience.

This is Bethany's "Village Logo". It is a characterization of our campus. Your challenge will be to "doodle" the logo while still keeping several elements.





Pablo Picasso (October 25, 1881 to April 8, 1973) was a Spanish expatriate painter, sculptor, printmaker, ceramicist and stage designer considered one of the greatest and most influential artists of the 20th century and the co-creator, along with Georges Braque, of Cubism.

This doodle would honor Pablo Picasso’s birthday on October 25. It has elements of not only actual works, but the logo itself has been manipulated. As you can see, the logo has been changed but certain elements are still visible. The first building is done in a style Picasso has used at a website called Lunapic. The chapel has been changed to reflect Picasso’s style and the St. Faith portion has cut out portions of Picasso’s famous paintings and the color has been changed. This was done in Activeinspire.

You are now tasked to create your own “Bethany Doodle”. You will work with Mr. LaValle to determine what your subject will be. Once this is done, you will sketch out your idea. Here are the only requirements to the doodle:

1. All three portions of the logo must be present in some form, order does not matter.
2. “Bethany School Est. 1898” must be visible in some form or another.
3. The Bethany logo on the chapel must also be present somewhere.
4. The theme must have an explanation included, such as the caption above.

Other than those 4 requirements, the sky is the limit!

Doodles will be placed on the school website as well as your own when complete. Also, you must find 4 other doodles of your friends and put those on your website with an explanation of what you liked most about them.
